I William Branch Campbell of Birmingham in the colony of New South Wales Gentleman do hereby revoke all former Wills and Testamentary dispositions made by me and declare this to be my last Will and Testament I appoint my son Alfred Branch Campbell and my friend John Archibald Aikin of Sydney in the said colony Solicitor (hereinafter called "my Trustee") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I direct my Trustees to pay all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I give and bequeath all my jewellery plate finer china glass books pictures furniture and other household effects to my daughter Elizabeth Campbell absolutely I give devise and bequeath all my real Estate and the residue of my personal Estate unto my Trustee Upon trust that my Trustee shall sell power call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and shall with and out of the money produced by such sale calling in and conversion and with and out of my ready money pay my Funeral and Testamentary expenses and debts and shall invest the residue of the said money with power for my Trustees from time to time to vary such investments And shall stand possessed of the said residuary trust-money and the investments for the time being representing the same (hereinafter called the residuary trust-funds) Upon the fruits following (that is to say) I trust to pay the income thereof

to my said Daughter Elizabeth Campbell during her life and  
from and after her decease I m trust for such of my Sons who  
shall survive my said Daughter (and if more than one in  
equal shares) absolutely And I declare that the share of my  
said Daughter under this my Will shall be for her sole and  
separate use and benefit And I also declare that the receipt  
in writing of my Trustees for any money securities or other  
personal property payable transferable or deliverable to them  
under any trust or power contained in this my Will shall  
be a sufficient discharge for the same and shall effectually  
exonerate the person or persons paying transferring or delivering  
the same from seeing to the application or being answerable  
for any loss or misapplication thereof And I also declare  
that the power of appointing new trustees conferred by  
Statute shall for the purposes of this my Will be vested in  
the continuing Trustee for the time being of this my Will  
or if there shall be no continuing trustee then in the retaining  
or refusing trustees or trustee or the executors or administrato-  
tors of the last acting trustee And lastly I declare that  
the said John Archibald Aikken shall be entitled to charge  
my Estate for all business done by him in relation to my  
Estate or the trusts of this my Will in the same manner  
as he would have been entitled to charge my Executors and  
Trustees for the same if he had not been himself an Executor  
or Trustee but had been employed by my Executors and Trustees  
to do such Business as their Solicitor I m Witness whereof  
I have set my hand to this my Will this second day of  
April one thousand nine hundred W B Campbell
