1. I HEREBY REVOKE all former Wills and Testamentary dispositions
heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament

2. I APPOINT my husband Stanley Hatton Greene and my daughter
Joyce Leila Greene (hereinafter called "my Trustees") Executors and
Trustees of this my Will

3. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH all my wearing apparel and articles of
personal adornment and all furniture and articles of household use
or ornament unto my daughter Joyce Leila Greene

4. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the residue of my estate unto my
Trustees UPON TRUST that they may sell call in and convert into
money the same and after payment thereof and out of my ready money
of all my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to stand
possessed of the net residue UPON TRUST to accumulate the income (if
any) to arise therefrom during the lifetime of my husband the said
Stanley Hatton Greene and on his death to divide my residuary trust
funds and the accumulated interest thereon in equal shares between my
children Connie Anne Wright, Joyce Leila Greene, Edgar Alfred Greene
and Trevor Clyde Greene

5. I DECLARE that if any child of mine shall have predeceased me
leaving a child or children who shall survive me or be born after my
death such issue shall take and if more than one then in equal shares
the share that his her or their parent would have taken of and under
this my Will had he or she survived me and attained the age of twenty-
one years

6. I EMPOWER my Trustees during the minority of any grandchild of
mine to apply the whole or such part as they shall think fit of the
capital or income of the expectant or presumptive share of such grand-
child for or towards his or her maintenance education or benefit with

power to pay the same to the guardian of such grandchild for the purpose aforesaid without seeing to the application thereof

7. I DECLARE that my Trustees may postpone the sale and conversion of any part of my real and personal estate for so long as they shall think fit and that the rents profits and income to accrue from and after my decease of and from such part of my estate as shall for the time being remain unsold and unconverted after payment thereof of all incidental expenses and outgoings to be paid and applied to the person or persons and in the manner and in which the income of the proceeds of such sale and conversion would for the time being be payable or applicable under this my Will if such sale and conversion had been actually made
