4 fols. I GIVE DEVISE BEQUEATH AND APPOINT the whole of my estate and effects both
real and personal and wheresoever situate unto my said Trustees UPON TRUST
to at such time or times as they in their sole and uncontrolled discretion
shall think fit sell call in and convert into money the same or such part
thereof as shall not consist of money and shall stand possessed of the net
proceeds of such sale calling in and conversion and of such part of my estate
as shall consist of money UPON TRUST to pay thereout my debts funeral and

testamentary expenses probate and death duties and to invest the balance and to pay the income derived from such investments or from such parts of my estate as shall for the time being be unconverted into money to my wife the said Katie Isabel Plummer during her lifetime and on the death of my said wife UPON TRUST to pay and divide the same between my children in equal shares and so that if any child of mine shall die in my lifetime leaving issue such issue shall take and if more than one equally between them the share in my estate which his her or their parent or parents respectively would have taken had such child survived me.
