OATH OF ENLISTMENT ‡

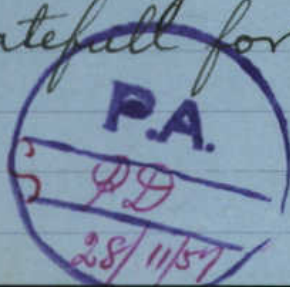
With reference to
