I was out with the Squadron when Campbell was killed. We were in extended order, and Campbell was some distance away. It was on the Alimuntur Ridge, Gaza, that he was shot by a bullet and died instantly. As far as I know he was left there. Campbell was on the tall side, medium complexion, about 26 years of age. He came from somewhere up on the Northern coast of N.S.W.

About two months later a message was dropped by a Turkish aeroplane that he (with others) had died of wounds in Hospital at Nazareth. About October 1917 I saw his grave in the Cemetery at Nazareth. It was ~~x~~ well kept, and had a cross with his particulars on it. He was a big chap about 5'11" fair, about 26 years old, and came from out near Adavale Q'land.

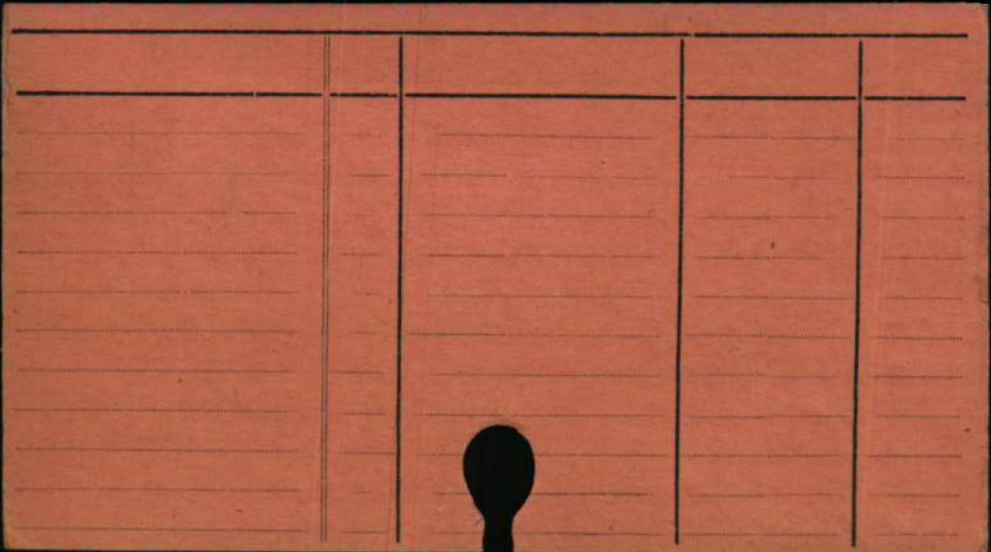

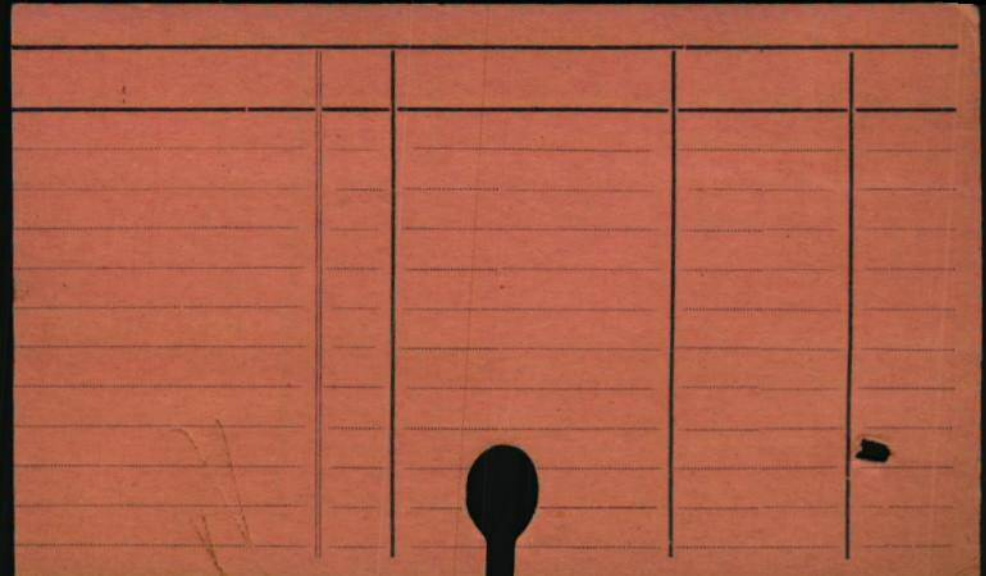

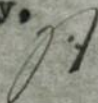
