trustee and executor I DIRECT my Trustee to divide the whole of my estate between
such of the following persons as shall be living at my death and in the following
shares namely the children of my deceased brother Leonard Plummer one share
equally between them the children of my deceased sister Ada Dutton one share equally
between them my sister Birdie Conroy one share the children of my deceased sister
Blanche Conroy one share equally between them my nephew Archie Robert Muir one share
the children of my deceased brother Lionel Plummer one share equally between them
and the children of my deceased sister Dagmar Mallinson one share equally between
them IF my sister Birdie Conroy shall predecease me leaving children me surviving
then such children shall take and if more than one equally between them the share
in my estate which she would have taken had she survived me I EMPOWER my Trustee
to postpone the realisation of my estate or any part thereof for such period or
periods as he may in his absolute discretion think fit I EMPOWER my Trustee to take
and act upon the opinion of any solicitor practising in Tasmania whether in relation

to the interpretation of this my will or any other document or statute or as to the administration of my estate without being liable to any of the persons beneficially interested in respect of any act done by my Trustee in accordance with such opinion but nothing in this clause contained shall prohibit my Trustee from applying to the Court if he should think fit or shall prohibit any of the beneficiaries from so doing IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this Fifteenth day of March One thousand nine hundred and sixty one.
