Dear Madam,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your husband, the late No. 1394, Driver J. W. McCauley, 34th Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he was evacuated from his Unit, sick, on 5.11.18, and admitted on 10.11.18 to 9th Australian Field Ambulance suffering from influenza. He was then transferred to 3rd Australian General Hospital, Abbeville, France, where he died on 19.11.18 from broncho pneumonia. He was buried in Abbeville Communal Cemetery Extension.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted to the graves of our fallen soldiers, and photographs are being taken as soon as possible for transmission to next-of-kin.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.

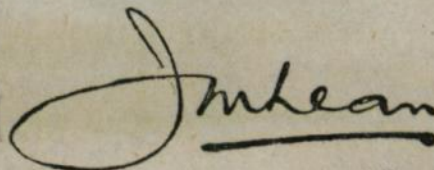
